Mid-Winter Conference News: With a hospitality welcome, District 20 gathered in-person once again to check in on each other and on the "condition" of the District. Opening ceremonies on Saturday were highlighted by remarks from Bishop Spyridon of Amastris, Supreme Governor Alexander Mallas, and Grand Governor Robbie Jackson. District Governors Peter Marudas and Carol Stathopoulos also welcomed the 30 Ahepans and 20 Daughters of Penelope in attendance.

The highlight of the joint morning session was an announcement by Brent Noyes, President of the El Camino Real District 20 AHEPA Scholarship Foundation, of a private foundation bequest in the amount of \$100,000 for each of the next 10 years, for the sole purpose of enhancing the amount of scholarship funds awarded to each scholarship recipient. The total bequest, over the ten year period, will add \$1,000,000 to the funds available for scholarship giving. Scholarship applications are online at <a href="https://doi.org/10.2007/nd.

Separate sessions filled the remainder of the conference, but both the Ahepans and the Daughters held "roundtable" discussions regarding the impact of Covid-19 on membership, meeting attendance, and fundraising projects. The Sisters spoke about obstacles to recruiting new, younger members; and how to better draw in prospective members by describing the entity or project which we are representing and fundraising. It was also mentioned that instead of passively collecting funds or selling an item, to make any fundraising effort an event that people can participate in actively.

The conference ended with a wonderful Italian Dinner at the Old Spaghetti Factory.
