District Obligations should be paid and the Chapter Financial Report Form should be completed and submitted to the appropriate individual no later than May 1.

As we prepare for District Convention on May 30-31, each chapter should begin working on their Chapter Report for the District Convention. This is the opportunity for each chapter to showcase each of the activities they have completed throughout the year. These should be submitted no later than May 15 in order for our DS Mercie to prepare our agenda packets for Convention.

If you elect a Chapter Penelope of the Year, send the application to DG Sofie no later than May 15 per the requirements on said application.

Lastly, elections should be held in either May or June to elect new officers for the upcoming year. When elections have taken place, chapters should complete the Chapter Election Form and submit to DG Sofie, DS Mercie, our Liaison, Grand Governor, Zone 4, Linda Belba, and Headquarters. Headquarters has requested that all chapters submit election forms no later than July 1.
